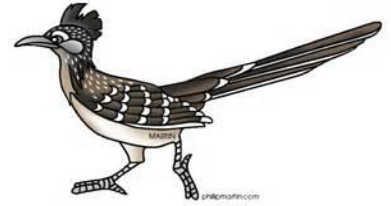


**MESQUITE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY
2017-2018**



- **Tops**: Solid navy blue, light blue, and white short or long sleeved collared shirts and blouses are allowed. Mesquite t-shirts are allowed and can be purchased from PTO through the school office.

- **Bottoms**: Blue or khaki pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers, dresses, and capris are allowed, as well as dark blue denim jeans and shorts. Shorts, skirts, skorts, dresses, and jumpers should be at least fingertip length when arms are at one's side. Shorts are to be worn under skirts. *Leggings alone are not allowed.*

- **Socks**: Any color socks may be worn under pants. White, blue, or beige tights, socks, and leggings are acceptable with skirts and shorts. Short shorts with leggings or tights are not allowed.

- **Shoes**: Closed shoes are to be worn on PE days. Low-heeled sandals with a back strap are permitted, but flip-flops, slippers, and heeies are not.

- **Outerwear**: Any color jacket, sweater, sweater vest, or sweatshirt is permitted for outside wear. Any writing on it is to be appropriate. Jackets or sweaters worn inside must be unzipped or unbuttoned to show the school uniform shirt. Hoodies are not allowed indoors unless they are Mesquite hoodies (available through PTO).

- **Hats**: Hats and hoods are permitted outside only. No hats or hoods are allowed inside.

Other: Artificial nails, make-up, and hair that is dyed an unnatural color are not permitted, per district dress code. The Casa Grande Elementary School District dress code is J-2361, JICA-R.

A student's parent/guardian may be contacted to bring a change of clothing if the student is not in uniform and alternative wear is not available in the office.
