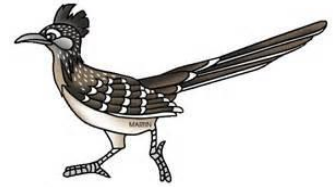


**MESQUITE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL  
SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY  
2016-2017**



- **Tops:** Solid navy blue, light blue, and white short or long sleeved collared shirts and blouses are allowed. Mesquite t-shirts are also allowed and can be purchased from PTO (beginning in August) through the school office or online at [www.spiritandpride.com](http://www.spiritandpride.com). School ID# 276357
- **Bottoms:** Blue or khaki pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers, dresses, and capris are allowed, as well as blue denim jeans and shorts. Shorts, skirts, skorts, dresses, and jumpers should be at least fingertip length when arms are at one's side. Leggings alone are not allowed.
- **Socks:** Any color socks may be worn under pants. White, blue, or beige tights, socks, and leggings are acceptable with skirts. Girls are encouraged to wear shorts under skirts. Short shorts with leggings or tights are not allowed.
- **Shoes:** Closed shoes are to be worn on p.e. days. Low-heeled sandals with a back strap are permitted, but flip-flops and slippers are not.
- **Outerwear:** During the cold weather months any color jacket, sweater, or sweatshirt is permitted for outside wear. These can be worn inside also, but need to be unzipped or unbuttoned to show the school uniform shirt. Hoodies are not allowed indoors unless they are Mesquite school hoodies (available at [www.spiritandpride.com](http://www.spiritandpride.com)).
- **Hats:** Hats and hoods are permitted outside only.
- **Other:** Artificial nails, make-up, and hair that is dyed an unnatural color are not permitted.

A student's parent/guardian may be contacted to bring a change of clothing if the student is not in uniform.

The Casa Grande Elementary School District dress code (J-2361, JICA-R) is also to be followed.
